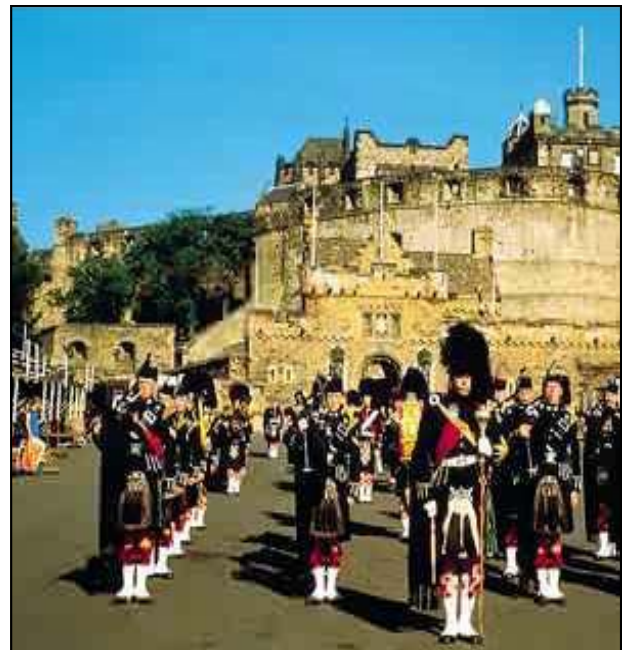

INFORMATION

• **Edinburgh:** Edinburgh's stunning skyline and magnificent architecture are captivating. The castle clings dramatically to its rock as the ancient buildings of the Royal Mile tumble down the spine of the hill to the splendid Palace of Holyrood House. Across the green expanse of Princes Street Gardens lies the graceful Georgian New Town waiting to be explored. Within a quarter of a mile clients can leave bustling Princes Street for an enchanting river sidewalk from Dean Vil-

lage or you could move from the Royal Mile to explore Arthur's Seat, the craggy extinct volcano that looms over the city.

• **Open Top Bus Tour:** The open top bus tour departs from outside the bus station, it lasts one and a half hour covering all major sights including the Royal Mile, Holyrood Palace and Greyfriars Bobby. The open top bus ticket is valid all day.

Entrance to the famous Edinburgh Castle is included.

Conditions

- Client has to make reservation at least 48 hours before tour starts by calling; London (0) 207 233 7030; 7h am–midnight, 7 days a week.
- Clients should arrive at London Kings Cross railway station at 6h30 am. There they will meet a Golden Tours representative by the ticket office who will check clients in and escort them to their pre reserved seats. Train departs at 7h am arriving in Edinburgh at 11h26 am.
- Tour finishes at approximately 10h15 pm
- The 'Day Trip to Edinburgh' is not covered by the Rail Protection Plan.

• Return journey:

Train departs Edinburgh rail station at 5h30 pm

Refund policy

- Vouchers may be refunded up to 6 months from the date of issue. A 15% cancellation penalty applies.
- Once the tour is confirmed with Golden Tours, voucher is not refundable.
