Unlimited travel throughout all six or the 2 central zones of London's buses and subways.

- **Valid from 01/01/2003 to 12/31/2003, subject to change**
- **Euronet code: BTC**

Features

- Unlimited travel :
 - throughout all six zones of London's buses and underground (subway) "All Zone"
 - throughout the 2 inner zones "Central Zone"
- Transfer from Heathrow Airport to any part of London and Ridership on the Docklands Light Railway (not valid with the Central Zone Card)
- Use of many mainline trains in the London area
- Discount booklet to popular attractions worth 40 pounds sterling (*The booklet is obtained by the client in London when exchanging the voucher against the actual card*)

Conditions

- Residents of United Kingdom are not eligible to purchase or use a London Visitor Travelcard.
- Voucher is valid for exchange up to 6 months from date of issue.
- Euronet voucher must be exchanged at one of the following London Transport Travel Information Centers situated at: *King's Cross, Liverpool Street, Oxford Circus, Piccadilly Circus, St James's Park, Heathrow 1,2 &3 Underground stations, Euston, Hammersmith, Victoria* and Paddington* main rail station concourses (*opposite platform 8), Waterloo International Arrivals Hall and Heathrow Terminals 1,2 & 4*

Refund policy

- No refund or adjustment can be made in the United Kingdom
- Vouchers must be submitted unused and not exchanged for a Visitor Traveler Card within 6 months of the issue date.
- A 15% cancellation penalty will be charged.
- Rail Protection Plan does not apply
