A great option for those who are planning to visit the land of the Danube River. Any 4 up to 10 days, consecutive or not, within 2 months Passes are available for Adult and Saver in first class flexi version and for Youth in second-class flexi version.

Features

- Unlimited travel on the national rail network of Austria, Slovenia and Croatia.
- 1st class (2nd class available for youth traveler only).
- Basic Pass : any 4 days within a 2- month period.
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively.

Children's rule

- Children from 4 up to 11 included on the first day of travel: reduced rates apply.
- Children up to 3 included on the first day of travel: free when sharing a paying adult passenger's seat/bed.

Options

- Ability to add up to 6 additional rail days.
- **Saver pass** for 2 to 5 adults traveling together at all times.
- **Youth pass** in 2nd class only, for travelers from 12 up to 25 included on the first day of travel.
- No Senior pass offered

CONDITIONS

- Passes must be validated within **6 months** of issuing date by a railway official in Austria, Slovenia or Croatia (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number.
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train (All parties must be present when validating a Saver-pass).
- The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train, **by the traveler**, in the corresponding box of the calendar.
- **7 pm rule:** if an overnight train starts after 7 pm on a validated Eurail Austria-Hungary Pass, the passholder must enter the next day's date on the

- pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.
- People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia or the Russian Federation are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Austria-Slovenia/Croatia Pass.
- A resident of Europe, the Russian Federation Turkey, Morocco, Algeria or Tunisia who temporarily reside in the US with a Visa (of any type) is not regarded as someone who is eligible to use or purchase this pass.
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass.



Refund policy

- Eurail Austria - Hungary Pass must be presented unused and not validated for refund.
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date.
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of the Rail Protection Plan.
