



Eurail Austria-Germany Pass

Benefits and Features

- ☉ Unlimited travel on the national rail network of Austria and Germany
- ☉ 1st and 2nd class
- ☉ Validities: any 5, 6, 8 or 10 days of unlimited train within a 2-month period
- ☉ Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- ☉ **Saver pass** for 2 to 5 adults traveling together at all times
- ☉ **Youth pass** in 2nd class only for travelers from 12 up to 25 included on the first date of travel

Options:

- ☉ No additional days can be added to this pass
- ☉ No Senior pass offered

Conditions of use

§ Passes must be validated within 6 months of issuing date by a railway official in Austria or

Germany (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number

§ Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train (All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass)

§ The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train, by the

traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar

§ 7:00pm rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Austria - Germany Pass,

the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass

§ People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom,

Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia or the Russian Federation are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Austria - Germany Pass.

§ A resident of Europe, the Russian Federation, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria or Tunisia who temporarily reside in the US with a Visa (of any type) is not regarded as someone who is eligible to use or purchase our documents.

§ Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass

Children's rule

- Children from 4 up to 11 included on the first day of travel: reduced rate applies.
- Children up to 3 included on the first day of travel: free when sharing an adult passenger's seat/ bed

Refunds

- Eurail Austria - Germany Pass must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- An 85% refund applies to totally unused passes returned within **6 months** of issuing date
- Eurail Austria - Germany Pass are not refundable and cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or partially used
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
