

# Eurail Austria - Hungary Pass

*Unlimited rail travel in Austria and Hungary. Available for Adult and Saver in 1st class flexi versions and 2nd class for Youth*

## Benefits and Features

- Unlimited travel on the national rail network of Austria and Hungary
- 1st class only (2nd class for Youth)
- Validity: any 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 days within a 2-month period
- Travel days may be used consecutively or nonconsecutively
- Also valid on direct trains between Salzburg and Kufstein (Germany) and Brennero – San Candido (Italy) if passenger does not change or leave the train.



## Options

- Saver pass for 2 or more traveling together
- Youth pass in 2nd class only, for travellers under 26 on their first day of travel

## Child Policy

- ☺ Discounted fare for children 4 – 11
- ☺ Children under 4 free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations



## Bonuses

*Bonuses are subject to change and availability and may require use of a travel day. Client is responsible to confirm bonuses locally.*

- Valid on InterCityBus Klagenfurt - Graz
- Valid on the railway lines from Ebenfurt to Sopron (Hungary) operated by the private railway company ROeEE
- 20% discount with DDSG Blue Danube on Danube river trips: Melk – Krems, Vienna – Dürnstein (Sundays only) & sight-seeing trips by boat in Vienna
- Special discounts on Danube river trip with Wurm & Köck from Linz to Passau
- A Eurail Pass valid in Hungary is also valid on the railway lines from Sopron to Ebenfurt (Austria) and from Sopron to Szentgotthárd operated by the private railway company GYSEV
- 50% discount on the entrance fee for the Hungarian Heritage Railway Park by motor train from Budapest- Nyugati station (seasonal opening hours).

## Conditions of use

1. Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Austria - Hungary Pass.
2. Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date by a railway official in Austria or Hungary (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number.
3. All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass
4. Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train or using a bonus
5. The date of travel must be entered before boarding the first train/bonus by the traveler in the corresponding box of the calendar
6. Persons using a U.S. Military I.D. are eligible to use this pass.
7. The 7 PM rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated pass the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.



## Refund Policy

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date
- Non refundable if lost or stolen except as covered by Rail Protection Plan
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
