

Eurail Denmark – Sweden Pass

Eurail Denmark – Sweden Pass provides rail travel in Denmark and Sweden. Available in 1st and 2nd class Adult and Saver versions and 2nd class Youth.

Benefits and Features

- Unlimited rail travel on the national rail networks of Denmark and Sweden
- 1st & 2nd class
- Validities 4, 5, 6, 8 or 10 days within a 2 month period
- Travel days may be used consecutively or nonconsecutively

Options

1. Saverpass for 2 or more traveling together
2. Youth pass in 2nd class only, for travelers under 26 on their first day of travel

Child Policy

- Discounted fare for children 4 – 11
- Children under 4 free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations



Bonuses

Bonuses are subject to change and availability and may require use of a travel day. Client is responsible to confirm bonuses locally.

→ A Eurail Pass valid in Sweden is also valid for travel: on the lines of the private railway companies Arlanda Express, Connex, Inlandsbanan, Merresor, Tågkompaniet and Veolia for travel from Göteborg and Stockholm to Oslo (Norway) in direct border crossing trains for travel to and from Copenhagen and Copenhagen Airport (Denmark) in direct SJ trains

Conditions of Use

- Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Denmark – Sweden Pass
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date by a railway official in Denmark or Sweden (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number.
- All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding first train or using a bonus
- The date of travel must be entered before boarding the first train/bonus by the traveler in the corresponding box of the calendar
- Persons using a U.S. Military I.D. are eligible to use this pass.
- The 7 PM rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00 pm on a validated pass the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass

Refund Policy

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date
- Non refundable if lost or stolen except as covered by Rail Protection Plan
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
