

Eurail Finland – Sweden Pass

Eurail Finland – Sweden Pass provides rail travel in Finland and Sweden. Available in 1st and 2nd class Adult and Saver versions and 2nd class Youth.

Benefits and Features

- Unlimited rail travel on the national rail network of Finland and Sweden
- 1st & 2nd class
- Validities: 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 days in 2 months
- Travel days may be used consecutively or nonconsecutively

Options

- Saverpass for 2 or more traveling together
- Youth pass in 2nd class only, for travelers under 26 on their first day of travel

Child Policy

- Discounted fare for children 4 – 11
- Children under 4 free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations



Bonuses

Bonuses are subject to change and availability and may require use of a travel day. Client is responsible to confirm bonuses locally.

→ bus connecting Finland and Sweden: Veljekset Salmela free transportation Bus: Kemi/Tornio - Haparanda (Sweden)

→ Tallink Silja Oy 50% discount Helsinki - Stockholm (via Mariehamn), Turku - Stockholm(via Mariehamn) and Helsinki - Tallinn: 30% discount Helsinki - Rostock. All discounts granted on the cabin category C-A.

Port taxes are extra.

Conditions of Use

- Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Finland – Sweden Pass
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date by a railway official in Finland or Sweden (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number.
- All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding first train or using a bonus.
- The date of travel must be entered before boarding the first train/bonus by the traveler in the corresponding box of the calendar
- Persons using a U.S. Military I.D. are eligible to use this pass.
- The 7 PM rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated pass the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass

Refund Policy

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date
- Non refundable if lost or stolen except as covered by Rail Protection Plan
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
