

## Eurail Global Pass

**Eurail Global Pass provides rail travel in the following 22 European countries: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland. (Liechtenstein and Monaco are considered part of Austria and France respectively). Adult and Saver versions are available in 1st class consecutive and flexi versions, Youth is available in 2nd class consecutive and flexi versions.**

### Benefits and Features

Unlimited rail travel on the national railroads of the participating 22 Eurail countries listed above

- 1st class (2nd class available for youth traveler only)
- Passes are also valid on some major shipping lines
- **Consecutive pass** validities 15 days, 21 days, 1 month, 2 months and 3 months
- **Flexi pass validities** 10 or 15 days within a 2-month period. Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively

### Rail pass Options

- Youth pass in 2nd class only, for travelers under 26 on their first day of travel
- Saverpass for two or more people traveling together

### Child Policy

- Discounted fare for children 4 - 11
- Children under 4: Free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations

### Some bonuses a rail pass offers

Bonuses are subject to change and availability and may require use of a travel day. Client is responsible to confirm bonuses locally.

- Passholder fares (compulsory reservations) available on TGV, Swiss Panoramic Trains, Eurostar, Thalys, Spanish Day and Night Trains, Genève Med, TGV Lyria, Bruxelles-France TGV, Swedish Trains, Artesia Night, Paris-Germany Night, CityNightLine, Lusitania, Elipsos, Trenitalia Domestic, Trenitalia International, Teoz, Lunea
- Valid in Germany on the S-Bahn (local railways) that operates in the major German cities. The only exception is Berlin, where the Eurail Pass is only valid on the S-Bahn tracks that connect the DB railway stations of Berlin

### Packaging Instructions

- Rail passes must be stapled in an All Aboard ticket cover.
- Include 1 Eurail Traveler's Guide, Map and Timetable per pass

### Conditions

- Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Pass
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issuing date by a railway official in a train station (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
- All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train
- The date of travel has to be entered before boarding the first train/bonus by the traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass
- 7:00pm rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Pass the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass

### Refund policy

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date
- Non refundable if lost, stolen or partially used
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan™
