



# Eurail Greece' n Italy Pass

BENEFITS AND FEATURES

- Unlimited travel on the national rail network of Greece and Italy
- 1st class & 2nd class
- Basic Pass : any 4 days within a 2-month period
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- **Saver pass** for 2 to 5 adults traveling together at all times
- **Youth pass** in 2nd class only, for traveler from 12 up to 25 included on the first day of travel
- Free ferry crossings from Patras and Igoumenitsa to Ancona and Bari (Italy) operated by 'Superfast Ferries' and Blue Star Ferries. High season surcharge: June and September: € 10 per person; July and August: € 20 per person. Port taxes are extra.
- 50% reduction on the standard passenger fares and cabin fares on the crossings from Patras, Igoumenitsa and Corfu to Brindisi (Italy), operated by HML (Hellenic Mediterranean Lines)
- No reduction on De-Luxe cabins. Ferries operate from mid-June to mid-September.
- 20% reduction on a one-day-cruise from Athens to the isles of Aegina, Poros and Hydra, operated by Ionian Travel. For reservations: (+30) 210 523 9609.



### Options:

- Ability to add up to 6 additional rail days
- **No Senior pass** offered

REFUNDS

Greece



- Eurail Greece - Italy Pass must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- An 85% refund applies to totally unused passes returned within **one year** of issuing date
- Eurail Greece - Italy Pass are not refundable and cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or partially used
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan

Italy



- Passes must be validated within **6 months** of issuing date by a railway official in Greece or Italy (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train (All parties must be present when validating a Saver-pass)
- The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train, **by the traveler**, in the corresponding box of the calendar
- **7:00pm rule:** if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Greece - Italy Pass, the pass-holder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass
- People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia or the Russian Federation are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Greece'n Italy Pass
- A resident of Europe, the Russian Federation, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria or Tunisia who temporarily reside in the US with a Visa (of any type) is not regarded as someone who is eligible to use or purchase this pass.
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass
