

# Eurail Greece Pass

*Unlimited rail travel in Greece. Available in 1st class for Adult and Youth.*

## Benefits and Features

- Unlimited travel on the national rail network of Greece.
- 1st class only
- Validity: any 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, or 10 days in a 1 month period.
- Rail travel days may be used consecutively or non consecutively.



## Options

- Youth pass in 1st class only, for travelers under 26 on their first day of travel
- No Saver pass offered

## Child Policy

- Discounted fare for children 4 – 11
- Children under 4 free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations

## Bonuses



*Bonuses are subject to change and availability and may require use of a travel day. Client is responsible to confirm bonuses locally.*

1. 20% reduction on the prices of the sea crossing between Italy and Greece and v.v. on the lines Ancona – Patras and Bari – Patras. Port taxes to be paid extra. Reservations locally.
2. 20% reduction on the prices of the sea sections between Piraeus and the Aegean islands served by the shipping company “Attica Enterprises/Blue Star Ferries”. Reservations locally.
3. 25% reduction on the price of one day cruise from Athens to Aegina – Poros – Hydra, offered by Ionian Travel Organization ( address above-mentioned ). 15% reduction on the prices of hotels in Athens offered by Ionian Travel.

## Conditions of use

- Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Greece Pass
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date by a railway official in Greece (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number.
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding the first train/ship.
- The date of travel has to be entered before boarding the first train/ship, by the traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar
- InterCity (IC) price supplements are included in the price with the exception of the InterCity Express (ICE) trains.
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass
- 7.00 pm rule: if an overnight train starts after 7.00 pm on a validated Eurail Greece Pass, the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.



## Refunds

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated.
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within one year of issue date.
- Non refundable if lost or stolen except as covered by Rail Protection Plan
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
