



Eurail France-Spain Pass

BENEFITS AND FEATURES

- Unlimited travel on the national rail network of France and Spain
- 1st class & 2nd class
- Basic Pass : any 4 days within a 2-month period
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- **Saver pass** for 2 to 5 adults traveling together at all times
- **Youth pass** in 2nd class only, for traveler from 12 up to 25 included on the first day of travel

Options:

- Ability to add up to 6 additional rail days
- No Senior pass option

**20% reduction on :**

- The Discovery Pass for guided tours and museums in Dijon
- The Grevin waxwork museums in Paris, Lourdes, Tours, Salon de Provence or St Jean de Luz

- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issuing date by a railway official in France or Spain (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train (All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass)
- The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train, by the traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar
- **7:00pm rule:** if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail France - Spain pass, the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass
- People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia or the Russian Federation are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail France - Spain Pass.
- A resident of Europe, the Russian Federation, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria or Tunisia who temporarily reside in the US with a Visa (of any type) is not regarded as someone who is eligible to use or purchase this pass.
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass

Refunds

- Eurail France - Spain Pass must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- An 85% refund applies to totally unused passes returned within **one year** of issuing date
- Eurail France - Spain Pass are not refundable and cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or partially used
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan

Access to high speed trains

- **Passholder fares** on domestic TGVs, Eurostar, Thalys, Artesia Day & Night, Elipsos, TGV Lyria, Paris-Germany Night, AVE, Talgo 200 and Bruxelles-France TGV.
- Valid on the RER-lines B (only Airport CDG-Paris Nord), C (Orly Airport-Downtown Paris, Versailles), D (Auvers-sur-Oise) & E. Not valid on RER A (Disneyland Paris), RER B's urban section (Paris center), Metro and buses.

1. Can I take TGV, AVE, Talgo trains with a Eurail France 'n Spain Pass?

Eurail France 'n Spain Passes are accepted on TGV, AVE and Talgo trains. Reservation/passholder is compulsory and at additional cost

2. Why make reservations?

Reservations are compulsory on all TGVs, Talgos, AVE, international and night trains. In general, we always recommend reservations for journeys of 2 hours and more as it guarantees a seat on a train and is definitely a small cost for extra comfort and peace of mind

3. Can I add additional days once I arrive in France or Spain?

No, additional days are only available through Rail Europe and cannot be purchased locally

4. Do I have to make sleeper reservations even though I have a rail pass/Do I have to make reservations if I bought a Eurail France 'n Spain Pass?

A Eurail France' n Spain Pass does not guarantee seat/sleeper reservation. Reservations are mandatory on all TGV, AVE, Talgo, Talgo 200, Euromed, Altaria, Alaris and night trains.

5. Are meals included in 1st class?

Meals are not included in 1st class when traveling on domestic French routes. However buffet carts are available in all TGVs trains and most stations features delis/bakeries. A meal is included in 1st class on the following trains in Spain:

- AVE (Madrid-Seville)
- Altaria (Madrid-Alicante, Madrid-Barcelona)
- Alaris (Madrid-Valencia)
- Talgo 200 (Madrid-Malaga)
- Euromed (Barcelona-Valencia)

· Gran Class tickets (Spanish night trains/Elipsos) include dinner and breakfast

6. Do people always need to travel together on a Saverpass?

All passengers listed on the Saverpass must be present at the time of validation of their pass. All or only part of the group may travel but only upon presentation of the Saverpass and the control coupons (which means that the remainder passengers listed on the pass cannot travel separately)

6. Can you return to France once you go to Spain/Can you return to Spain once you go to France?

Yes you can. Client is free to organize his/her itinerary as he/she wishes (ex. 5-day pass holder can spend 4 days traveling in

France and 1 day traveling in Spain or 5 days traveling within Spain and not go to France at all)

7. Do I get a passholder fare on Lusitania (Madrid-Lisbon)

No Eurail France 'n Spain Pass holders are not entitled to a passholder fare on Lusitania. A separate ticket must be purchased

8. Which ticket should I purchase to travel on Elipsos?

A passholder fare is the best and cheapest option

9. How can I travel between Paris and Barcelona by day?

TGV Med from Paris Gare de Lyon to Montpellier and Talgo Day train is the best combination
