# Eurail Denmark-Germany Pass

## BENEFITS AND FEATURE

- Unlimited travel on the national rail network of Denmark and Germany
- 1st class & 2nd class
- Basic Pass : any 5, 6, 8 or 10 days within a 2-month period
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- **Saver pass** for 2 to 5 adults traveling together at all times
- **Youth pass** in 2nd class only, for travelers from 12 up to 25 included on the first day of travel

### Options:

- No Senior pass offered
- No additional days can be added

### Children's rule

- Children from 4 up to 11 included on the first day of travel: reduced rate applies.
- Children up to 3 included on the first day of travel: free when sharing an adult passenger's seat/ bed

- Passes must be validated within **6 months** of issuing date by a railway official in Denmark and Germany (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train (All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass)
- The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train, **by the traveler**, in the corresponding box of the calendar
- **7:00pm rule:** if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Denmark - Germany, the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass § People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia or the Russian Federation are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Germany-Denmark Pass
- A resident of Europe, the Russian Federation, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria or Tunisia who temporarily reside in the US with a Visa (of any type) is not regarded as someone who is eligible to use or purchase this pass.
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass

\* *Comprehensive conditions of use on the Eurail pass cover.*

- Eurail Denmark-Germany Pass must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- An 85% refund applies to totally unused passes returned within **one year** of issuing date
- Eurail Denmark-Germany Pass are not refundable and cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or partially used
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
