

EUROSTAR NEW TRAIN STATION IN LONDON

Eurostar train services moves from London Waterloo to St Pancras International.

Eurostar, the high speed passenger train operator between the UK and France and Belgium will become even more accessible to continental Europe for the travellers across southern England.

On November 14th, Eurostar launches services from St. Pancras International, which is served by new high speed rail line, replacing the Waterloo train station. The new Eurostar journeys will departure from London St. Pancras via a new train station in the north of Kent, called Ebbsfleet International, which is modern, beautifully designed to be the fastest way to Europe.

London and Paris getting closer

Journey times from St Pancras to the Continent will be 20 minutes shorter than from Waterloo and 40 minutes shorter if the destination is Ebbsfleet International. It will also be the best option to many Eurostar travelers who currently drive to their local station as the Ebbsfleet Station offer 2500 car park spaces.



These two new options will bring mainland Europe closer for almost 10 million people in the catchment area of the station.

St Pancras Station will have fantastic connections to London and the UK – far better than Waterloo International. It'll be served by 6 subway lines and there will also be 7 rail companies connecting to the rest of the UK.

Eurostar will continue operate a full timetable to and from Waterloo International until November 13th.
