France – Geneve TGV trains operate between Paris and Geneva.

Valid from 01/01/2006 to 12/31/2006, subject to change

Features

- *Routes and travel times:*
Paris – Mâcon 1h 45
Paris – Bourg-en-Bresse 2h 00
Paris – Bellegarde 3h 10
Paris – Geneve 3h 45
Geneve – Bellegrade 30 min
Geneve – Bourg-en-Bresse 1h 35
Geneve – Mâcon 1h 55
Geneve – Paris 3h 45
- *Accommodations:* The France – Geneve TGVs has been redesigned (new design-blue & gray colors, spacious interior and more comfortable seats) and the service has been improved.
- *Frequencies:* 7 daily France – Geneve round trips (except Saturdays) are running.
- Smoking is not allowed on the France - Geneve TGV

Conditions

- Advance Booking: France - Geneve TGVs can be booked up to 60 days in advance.
- While discounted fares are offered for pass holders, the client still needs to buy a TGV ticket.
- For passholder fares: pass needs to be validated prior to boarding the France - Geneve TGVs. To apply for a Pass holder fare, Flexipass holders need to use a travel day on their Flexipass for a France - Geneve TGV journey.

Issued as combined ticket and reservation

FARE TYPES	FRANCE– GENEVE TGV
Adult full fare	Fully exchangeable and refundable
Child	Travelers under 12 on train's departure date - Free if under 4 (if no seat required)
Kid & co (adult and child)	Discount for an adult traveling with a child under 12 years of age on the TDD. Maximum 2 adults per child
Book early	14 days advanced purchase. Non exchangeable, non refundable. Available in 1st and 2nd class. Paris– Geneve or v.v.
Leisure	Compulsory round trip + one overnight stay
Youth	Travelers under 26 on train's departure date
Senior	Travelers over 60 on train's departure date
Pass 1	For Eurailpass/ Eurail Selectpass (incl. France and Switzerland) / France`n Switzerland Pass
Pass 2	For France Railpass/ Eurail Selectpass (incl. France) Eurail France`n Italy Pass (with use of one day on the Pass) and Eurail France`n Spain Pass holders
Pass 3	For Swiss Pass/ Swiss Flexipass/ Swiss Saverpass/ Swiss Youth pass, Switzerland`n Austria Pass and Eurail Select (incl. Switzerland) holders
Wheelchair	Wheelchair/ Blind passenger
Companion	Wheelchair/ Blind passenger companion

Refund policy

- Exchange and refund policies vary depending on the type of fare purchased. Refunds, when authorized, can only be performed in North America up to 60 days after train's departure date.
- Exchange can only be performed by Euro Railways. To exchange a ticket, a new ticket must be issued and the unused one sent back to Euro Railways for a refund within the time frame allowed for such refund. A handling fee may apply. The refund granted on the returned ticket depends on the refund policy of that particular fare.
- Lost or stolen travel documents may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan
