Premier Train: France, Switzerland

Accommodation:

- Refurbished exterior and interior, spacious seating organization, brand new seats and floors. On board nursery equipped with dressing table and bottle-warmer in 2nd class car.
- On board information messages recorded in French, German and English. Served in bar car (open between Paris-Frasne): Breakfast formula, large assortment of meals, warm and cold dishes, sandwiches, dessert and warm and cold beverages. In first class, snack trolleys are available.
- Facilities for handicapped travelers. Dedicated car in 1st class (accessible with 2nd class ticket) with a built-in wheelchair lift and wheelchair space.
- Completely **Non-Smoking** cars. Smoking is not allowed.
- For first class Paris-bound travelers, taxi reservations can be made on board with the conductor (at client's expense). Once confirmed, passenger will receive a receipt with the confirmation number. Clients will need to proceed to the 'Accueil Taxis Reserves' area upon
- Arrival at Paris Lyon where a driver will be waiting



for them with a sign.

- The TGV Ski Train "TGV des Neiges" between Paris and Montreux, Aigle, Martigny, Sion, Sierre and Brig operates in Winter only

These fares are valid only for international sectors. For domestic sectors on these trains, a Eurailticket + reservation must be issued.
Premier train fee applies.

- Advance Booking: Lyria can be booked up to 90 days in advance.
- While discounted fares are offered to certain pass holders, the client still needs to buy a TGV ticket.
- For pass holder fares: pass needs to be validated prior to boarding the Lyria. To apply for a Passholder fare, Flexipass holders need to use a travel day on their Flexipass for a Lyria journey. The class of service of the ticket must match the class of service on the Railpass.

Refund policy

- Exchange and refund policies vary depending on the type of fare purchased. Refunds, when authorized, can only be performed in North America up to 60 days after train's departure date.
- Exchange can only be performed by the issuing office. To exchange a ticket, a new ticket must be issued and the unused one sent back to the issuing office for a refund within the time frame allowed for such refund. A handling fee may apply. The refund granted on the returned ticket depends on the refund policy of that particular fare.
