

## Eurail Scandinavia Pass

***Eurail Scandinavia Pass provides rail travel in Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden; available for Adult, Saver and Youth in second class flexi versions.***

### ***Benefits and Features***

Unlimited rail travel on the national railroads of the Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden

- Travel on the national rail networks of Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden
- 2nd class only
- Validity: 4, 5, 6, 8 or 10 days in 2 months
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- For travel in comfort 2nd Class on NSB regional trains a supplement needs to be paid locally. Complimentary tea/coffee is served.

### ***Rail pass Options***

- Youth pass in 2nd class only, for travelers under 26 on their first day of travel
- Saverpass for two or more people traveling together

### ***Child Policy***

- Discounted fare for children 4 - 11
- Children under 4: Free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations

### ***Some bonuses a rail pass offers***

Bonuses are subject to change and availability and may require use of a travel day. Client is responsible to confirm bonuses locally.

- Access to special trains with supplement/ Passholder fare reservation on: Pendolino, IC (Finland), Swedish Day Trains ( X2000 and Linx) and night trains - supplement applies
- Bus connecting Finland and Sweden: Veljekset Salmela free transportation Bus: Kemi/Tornio - Haparanda (Sweden)

### ***Packaging Instructions***

- Rail passes must be stapled in an All Aboard ticket cover.
- Include 1 Eurail Traveler's Guide, Map and Timetable per pass

### ***Conditions***

- Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Pass
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issuing date by a railway official in a train station (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
- All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding 1st train
- The date of travel has to be entered before boarding the first train/bonus by the traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar
- Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass
- 7:00pm rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Pass the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass

### ***Refund policy***

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date
- Non refundable if lost, stolen or partially used
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan™
