

Jungfrauojoch - Top of Europe

Round trip travel from Interlaken, Grindelwald or Wengen to the Jungfrauojoch - at 11,333 feet, the highest railway station in Europe.

Benefits and Features

- Entitles the holder to round trip travel to the Jungfrauojoch – Top of Europe from Interlaken, Grindelwald or Wengen.
- This unique round-trip by modern cogwheel railway first takes client to Kleine Scheidegg, altitude 2,061 meters (6,762 feet), at the foot of the notorious Eiger North Wall. From here, the Jungfrau Railway climbs to the Eiger Glacier Station, well known for its mountain restaurant and polar dog kennels.
- The trip continues through the Eiger tunnel, to the Eigerwand and Eismeer stations, with a five-minute stop at each station where you can enjoy spectacular sightseeing through large observation windows, hewn from solid Alpine rock.
- The train from Lauterbrunnen-Wengen or Grindelwald up to Kleine Scheidegg (change of trains) and then up to the Jungfrauojoch only carries 2nd class seats.
- Attractions at the top include the Great Aletsch Glacier, at 22 km (13.6 miles) the longest ice-stream in the Alps, begins directly on the Jungfrauojoch. Ice Palace, Ice Gateway, Sphinx observation terrace, Plateau with hiking in the eternal snow, "Top of Europe" Glacier Restaurant, summer ski & snowboard park, huskydrawn sled rides, summer adventure attractions and High Alpine Research Exhibitions.

Exchange Points

- The voucher has to be exchanged at the train station in Interlaken Ost, Grindelwald or Wengen.

Child Policy

- With a Swiss Pass: Free Swiss Family Card allows children under 16 to travel free with a parent or legal guardian
- With a Eurail Pass and children traveling without a parent: Discounted fare for children 6 – 15
- Children under 6 free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations

Conditions

- Eurail Passes that include Switzerland are valid until Interlaken - Swiss Passes until Grindelwald/Wengen.
- Eurail Pass holders receive a reduced fare from Interlaken and Swiss Pass holders receive a reduced fare from Grindelwald/Wengen.
- Full fare applies to point-to-point tickets, Swiss Transfer Tickets or any other ticket.


Refund policy
