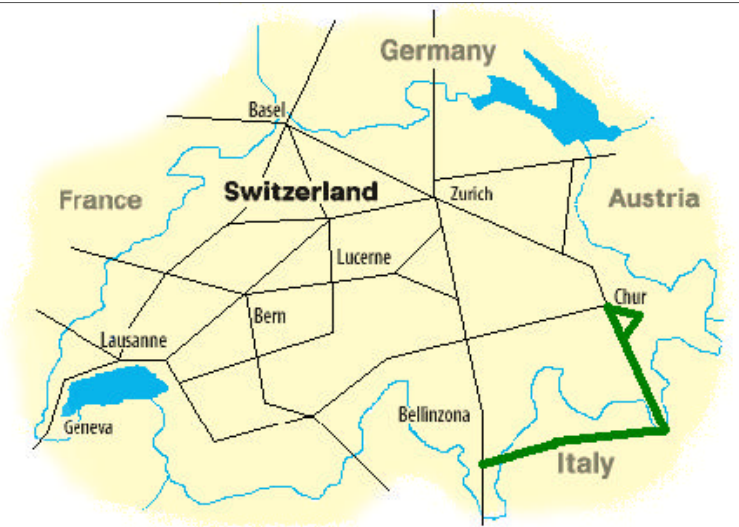
Features

- The Rhaetian Railway's north-south Alpine crossing offers breathtaking views from the new panoramic cars traveling over boldly curved viaducts, through winding tunnels and past ice-age glaciers. From Tirano, the excursion continues in modern buses through the Valtelina Valley to Lugano (Bus from Tirano to Lugano only during summer).

Routes

→ Bernina Express: Chur – Albula Valley – Pontresina – Bernina Pass – Poschiavo – Tirano (– Lugano)

→ Heidi Express: Landquart – Davos – Pontresina – Tirano. Scheduled trains run almost every hour between St. Moritz and Tirano, over the Bernina Pass. For these trains, seat reservations are not possible.



The north-south Alpine crossing from Chur to Lugano offers breathtaking views as you travel from ice-age glaciers to palm trees. From Tirano, the excursion continues in modern buses through the Italian Valtelina Valley to Lugano.
