Lucerne – Brünig - Interlaken (change),
Interlaken – Spiez - Zweisimmen (change),
Zweisimmen – Gstaad – Montreux.

Accommodations

- Lucerne-Interlaken East: 1st cl. panoramic car, 2nd cl. car, (restaurant & bar car)
- Interlaken East - Zweisimmen: Salon car and Golden Pass lounge in 1st cl only. 2nd cl car, rail bar service.
- Zweisimmen - Montreux: Panoramic cars in 1st and 2nd cl; rail bar service.
- **Wheelchairs:** The panoramic trains from Montreux to Zweisimmen have an incorporated lift for wheelchairs. Reservations can be made 24 hours before your departure at the following phone number: 0041 21 989-8190. This seat can only be reserved via telephone.

Child Policy

- With a Swiss Pass: Free Swiss Family Card allows children under 16 to travel free with a parent or legal guardian
- With a Eurail Pass and children traveling without a parent: Discounted fare for children 4 - 11

Conditions of use

- Reservations are compulsory and at an additional cost.
- Advanced booking: up to 90 days in advance

Fare Types

Swiss Pass, Swiss Flexi Pass

- The whole trip from Lucerne to Montreux is covered by the pass
- Seat reservations on the Golden Pass train are recommended and at additional cost.

Traveling with a 1st class Swiss ticket

- Tickets available for the following routes: Lucerne - Montreux; Lucerne - Interlaken; Interlaken - Gstaad; Spiez - Montreux; Gstaad – Montreux.
- Seat reservation for the GoldenPass train is recommended and at additional cost

Traveling with any other pass that includes Switzerland:

- The whole trip from Lucerne to Montreux is covered by the pass
- Seat reservations on the GoldenPass train is recommended and additional

Refund policy

- Reservation fees are not refundable and not valid for Rail Protection Plan™.
